



## Beta v0.4 change log

- PrivateStorage builds have been upgraded to use and ship with Python version 3.7 on all three platforms, resulting in (slightly) faster start-up times and improved memory-usage.
- On desktop environments that do not support a system tray, the application menu will now be accessible via a button in bottom-right corner of the status panel.
- The previously-ambiguous "remove" folder action and associated text has been renamed/clarified to "stop syncing" instead. In addition, stopping a folder from syncing will now unlink it from the user's rootcap/Recovery Key by default.
- Invalid invite codes will now be rejected immediately, preventing the situation in which the application might appear to become "stuck" at the initial connecting dialog.
- A rare crash that coincided with opening the native file-selector dialog on some ArchLinux systems has been fixed.
- An in-app notification channel has been added, allowing beta users to receive important messages pertaining to future software updates and service disruptions more directly and securely.
- The "Browse Documentation" help menu link now points to the new PrivateStorage knowledge base (<https://help.privatestorage.io/>)
