Linux and 4K monitors

You may experience a scaling issue on your linux device in conjunction with a 4K monitor. This will cause the applications buttons and features to malfunction or become unusable.

For most supported Linux Distros, you can resolve this by entering the command:

- `QT_SCALE_FACTOR=1`

If the scaling issue persists, on a non-Mate distro, please adjust your Auto scaling between 0.1-2.0

- `QT_SCALE_FACTOR=0.1/2.0 ./privatestorage`

To fix the issue if you are using Mate, before launching the app you will need to input the command

- `QT_AUTO_SCREEN_SCALE_FACTOR=0 ./privatestorage`
